



Communities in the Countryside & Prasart Banteay Ampil

Duration: Full day

This tour offers a unique opportunity to visit the remote countryside seen by few travelers. The non-profit Cambodian-Dutch Organization (CDO) works on community development projects. We visit one of their health centers and a primary school. The instructor, Mr. Lous, will introduce you to the class and you can do a "show and tell" about your life back home. Your support for this project is vital to its on-going success so that they can continue to purchase hospital equipment, books and other utensils for the children.

Enjoy a Cambodian lunch with staff of the CDO and depart for Andong Pei village. From here you will venture out by oxcart to Prasart Banteay Ampil, a quite exotic remote temple ruin that has been taken over by jungle vegetation. Chances are you will be the only people around.
