



LUANG PRABANG – WORLD HERITAGE

OVERVIEW:

Luang Prabang is known as one of the top destinations in the world. This is truly a place where it seems the outside world has not yet influenced the culture and way of life in the mountain villages surrounding the city. Come meet the kindest, most gentle people in the world who will surprise you with their genuine friendliness. The tranquility and charm of this city with its stunning natural scenery and cultural sights make Luang Prabang one of the most delightful places to visit in Laos.

ITINERARY:

Day 01: Arrival – Luang Prabang

Arrive in Luang Prabang and transfer to hotel for check in. After you have freshened up we will visit Wat Visoun, the 16th century temple which served as a small museum for religious artifacts; Wat Aham; Wat Xiengthong, the 16th century temple which, more than any temples in the area gives us a true sense of Luang Prabang architecture and climb up Phousi Hill, which dominates the sky-line overlooking the finest panoramic view you will see anywhere. From there, we explore Street Night Bazaar, where you can browse the lovely collection of handmade textiles by local hill tribe people

Day 02: Luang Prabang – Pak Ou Cave

We depart the hotel in the morning to the boat landing, and take an excursion upstream on the magnificent Mekong to visit Pak Ou caves cut into the side of a limestone cliffs and opposite the mouth of the Mekong and Ou rivers. The sanctuaries at Pak Ou consist of two large caves, both repositories for thousands of Buddha images, which range from a mere centimeter to two meters in height. En route, typical Lao villages are barely visible behind the thick foliage. Slender canoes bobbing by the shore, bamboo poles and floats mark the location of nets and fish traps. Our first stop will be at Ban Muangkeo, a village well-known for it's Lao traditional rice whisky, namely Laoh-Khao which we will have a tasting of. Lunch is served at a riverside restaurant. We arrive back at Luang Prabang in late afternoon and make a visit to the National Museum – the former Royal Palace.

Day 03: Luang Prabang – Departure

After breakfast, transfer to airport for flight departure.
